

RESOLUTION 2019-4
Appointing a Qualified Purchasing Agent and Increasing Bid Threshold
(pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-9(g))

WHEREAS, the recent changes to the Local Public Contracts Law gave local Contracting units the ability to increase their bid threshold up to \$40,000; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-3a permits an increase in the bid threshold if a Qualified Purchasing Agent is appointed as well as granted the authorization to negotiate and award such contracts below the bid threshold; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:34-5 et. Seq. establishes the criteria for qualifying as a Qualified Purchasing Agent; and

WHEREAS, Amy Spera, QPA will be filling the vacancy of a Qualified purchasing Agent.

WHEREAS, the Belmar Housing Authority wishes to take advantage of the increased bid threshold:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Belmar Housing Authority in the County of Monmouth, in the State of New Jersey hereby increases its bid threshold to \$40,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners hereby appoints Amy Spera, QPA, to fill the vacancy of Qualified Purchasing Agent from January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019 at an annual stipend of \$1,000.00 per year. Qualified Purchasing Agent is authorized to exercise the duties of a purchasing agent pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-2(30), with specific relevance to the authority, responsibility, and accountability of the purchasing activity of the contracting unit; and
